LIBRARY

Volunteering in the library consists of performing some low-key but critically needed tasks in a (usually) quiet space. These tasks include shelving books, check-in and check-out of books, preparing new books for cataloging and other library projects.

PUBLISHING CENTER

THEATER

Fundraising Committees

AUCTION COMMITTEE

Parent Association at the Logan School [PALS]

PALS' purpose is to build and support community at The Logan School.

CLASS REPRESENTATIVES

One parent community member from each classroom facilitates communication from PALS to the parents. They coordinate community events outside of school, and support the teacher as needed, which may include assistance in planning an auction project or gathering materials.

COMMUNITY COMMITTEE

If you're interested in growing Logan's culture of parent involvement and support for the school and fostering new friendships and relationships, please consider this committee. During the school year, the Community Committee hosts a "Coffee and Kleenex" at the beginning of school, the PALS Welcome Picnic and other community building events.

LITERARY EVENTS

PALS needs your help to make our literary events financially rewarding. To support the important work of PALS, we hold the Logan BookMarket in the fall. There are many opportunities to get plugged in to the community by dedicating a few hours to this wildly popular event.

STAFF SUPPORT COMMITTEE

If you share our belief that staff are the backbone and reflect the soul of Logan, and you want to express your gratitude to them, then the Staff Support Committee is the place for you. The Staff Support Committee hosts the staff holiday party, coordinates lunch for staff during conferences, and shows appreciation all year long.

SUNSHINE COMMITTEE

The Sunshine Committee brings a little cheer to people in the Logan community who are going through a hard time (e.g. dealing with serious illness or have had a death in the family) by cooking and delivering two meals to them. This is a great way to get involved in Logan, especially if your schedule makes it difficult to volunteer during the day.



Board of Trustees

The Board of Trustees is charged with promoting and protecting The Logan School's mission, ensuring the school's long-term financial viability, and ensuring the success of its Head of School. The Board's role is strategic, not operational.

COMMITTEES OF THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES

Board committees focus on issues that are vital to sustaining The Logan School's mission and vision; all report to the Board. Committee members are appointed by respective committee chairs with input from the Board. If you are interested in being considered for the Board of Trustees or serving on any of the Board committees listed below, please fill out the survey.

DEVELOPMENT

The Development Committee supports the mission and core values of The Logan School by promoting sustainable financial viability through fundraising and encouraging a culture of philanthropy throughout the Logan community.

ENDOWMENT INVESTMENT

The Endowment Investment Committee supports the development, implementation and monitoring of an appropriate investment strategy for Logan's Endowment Fund.

FINANCE

The Finance Committee reviews the annual audit and makes recommendations related to Logan's budgets, and long-range financial plan.

TRUSTEESHIP

The Trusteeship Committee ensures the effective governance of The Logan School. It recruits and recommends prospective trustees to the Board and oversees trustee elections. This committee also periodically reviews Logan's Bylaws and is responsible for trustee orientation and training.

403(B) RETIREMENT PLAN OVERSIGHT COMMITTEE

The 403b Committee is a subcommittee of finance and provides fiduciary oversight for the school's retirement plan and assures prudent process in the selection and monitoring of investments and accounts for employees of The Logan School. This committee's primary purpose is to focus on what is best for participants for the sole purpose of accumulating retirement savings.

Bridging the Gap

This year, the “gap” between the cost of tuition and the cost to educate each Logan student is \$2100 per student. As a 501c(3) organization, The Logan School depends on charitable gifts to sustain its mission. Our generous community's donations pay for a portion of educational expenses and bridge the “gap” in our annual operating budget.

TO BRIDGE THE GAP, PLEASE CONTRIBUTE TO:

THE ANNUAL FUND

Each year, all families are asked to show their support by making a donation to The Annual Fund. Last year we reached 92% current family participation, and this year and every year, we aim for 100%. This year, the Annual Fund goals are \$258,000 and 100% participation from the Logan community.

The Annual Fund is a critical component of the annual operating budget. It supports teacher salaries, financial aid, professional development, facility and grounds maintenance and much more.

100% participation reflects community strength, shared vision and a commitment to Logan's values. This helps Logan become eligible for additional funding from corporations and foundations.

THE ANNUAL AUCTION

The Annual Auction raises money to supplement the operating budget for the current fiscal year (in conjunction with The Annual Fund).

The Auction provides a venue for the whole community to come together and support The Logan School.

The 2020 Annual Auction will be held on Friday, April 17, 2020, at the Wellshire Event Center.

THE LOGAN ENDOWMENT FUND

Logan's endowment creates long-term fiscal sustainability for the school.

The interest on the endowment principal supports operations, teacher salaries and financial aid.

THE LOGAN BANNER SOCIETY

The Logan Banner Society is a group of donors who have included Logan in their wills or other estate plans. Their gifts provide essential financial support for the school's future, and each contribution makes a positive difference in the educational opportunities we are able to provide. Planned giving, allows donors to “leave a legacy.” It allows donors to have an impact on Logan beyond their lifetime.
